little - few a little - a few

1. **little** = *pequeño/a pequeños/as* (*con un nombre contable*)

> There are thousands of **little** ants in my kitchen. How can I get rid of them?

*(Hay miles de **pequeñas** hormigas en mi cocina. ¿Cómo puedo eliminarlas?)*

2. **little** = *poco, poca* (*con un nombre no contable*)

> I have **little** money, but I am very happy.

When you have **little** work experience, it can be hard to find a job.

Enjoy the **little** things, for one day you might look back and realize they were the big things. **Robert Brault**

*(Disfruta de las **pequeñas** cosas, porque un día podrías mirar atrás y darte cuenta que eran las grandes cosas.)*

1. **a little** = *un pequeño, una pequeña* (*con un nombre contable*)

> My husband and I live in **a little** house. We have **a little** baby girl, **a little** car, **a little** cat and **a little** dog.

2. **a little** = *un poco de* (*con un nombre no contable*)

> For lunch we usually have **a little** soup, **a little** bread, **a little** cheese, and **a little** wine. Afterwards we have **a little** rest.

Nota

Se puede decir también:

some soup, **some** bread, **some** cheese, **some** wine, **some** rest.

1. **few** = *pocos - pocas*

- > It is better to have **few** true friends than lots of fake friends.
(*Es mejor tener pocos verdaderos amigos que muchos falsos amigos.*)

1. **a few** = *algunos - algunas*

- > I would like to ask you **a few** questions about English pronunciation.

I would like to ask you **some** questions about English pronunciation.
