y también

I am able to play tennis very well.

Past Simple

= pasado simple (imperfecto-indefinido)

could

= podía, pude - sabía, supe (hacer una cosa)

When I was younger I could climb tall trees.

y también

When I was younger I was able to climb tall trees.

Nota

Generalmente, "can" y "could" son intercambiables con "I am able to" y "I was able to", pero "can" y "could" son más comunes.

Diferencia entre "could" y "was able"

- Last year I made so much money that I could buy a Ferrari. (Podía comprarla, pero no lo hice.)
- Last year I made so much money that I was able to buy a Ferrari.

(Podía comprarla, y <u>lo hice</u>.)
