also - too - as well = *también*

Also - too - as well tienen el mismo significado, pero se colocan en diferentes posiciones en la frase.

also *Also* se pone *en medio* de la frase.

Antes del verbo

- > Abel not only speaks English fluently, he **also speaks** Spanish and Italian.

Después de to be

- > Debra is not only pretty, she **is also** very clever.

Después de un modal (can, may, must etc.)

- > Debra can play the piano, and she **can also** sing very well.

too

Too se coloca generalmente *al final* de la frase.

- > Debra can play the piano, and she can sing very well **too**.

Too se pone también *en medio* de la frase, pero entre comas.

- > I, **too**, believe that all men are created equal.

as well

As well se coloca *al final* de la frase.

- > Tom likes beer, and he likes red wine **as well**.
